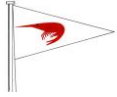

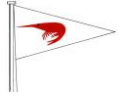

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Please note

Boat Park fees for non-members are double the rate shown.

Boat Park fees for dinghies belonging to juniors are half the rate shown.

Applications for multiple spaces or those from non-members or for cruisers, fishing, and motor boats require approval from the General Committee.

The annual fee is due on the 1st January.

If a fee remains unpaid for 3 months from the due date or from the date a space is allocated, boats and trailers may be moved from any allocated space and a 10% surcharge will apply.

If a fee remains unpaid for six months, the committee may remove any boats and trailers from the boat park and dispose of it in any way they think fit.

Everyone who uses the Boat Park shares a responsibility for keeping it in good order.

Here are a few rules to help us achieve this.

- Only serviceable boats on trailers can be stored in the boat park.
- It is not acceptable to store junk or to undertake long term projects in the boat park.
- Boats, trailers or any other equipment must not be deposited in the boat park without the express permission of the Boat Park Secretary, or the Committee as appropriate.
- Trailers and associated equipment must be kept within the space allotted to that member.
- Motor vehicles are only to enter the boat park where absolutely necessary to stow - or retrieve boats / trailers.
- No motor vehicles whatsoever to be parked in the boat park. Engine oil gets onto the grass, and then onto people's sails and equipment.

The Boat Park Secretary must be told about any changes regarding the use of the boat park, for example, a change of boat or trailer or owner.

Users of the boat park are responsible for looking after their allocated space and are expected to keep the grass cut and remove any litter in their area.

There will be work parties organised during the season to maintain the boat park and users are required to make time to assist with this.
